

Distribution of Materials in Schools Policy

Any non-commercial document, flyer, letter or announcement that will serve to inform students, parents or faculty of upcoming events may be distributed upon the approval of the Superintendent.

The distribution of printed or electronically generated (transmitted) commercial materials within the public schools is prohibited without the consent of the Board.

The Board, through the Superintendent of Schools, shall determine which materials can be received, distributed, displayed, or circulated within any school building.

The intent of this policy is to protect against possible exploitation of students through advertising or promotional interests of non-school agencies or organizations.

The Board's decision will prevail.

This policy is not to be construed as censorship, but an exercise of the Board's obligation to select curricular materials for distribution to students in the schools.
