2020-2021 Meal Service During COVID-19

For Students Returning to In-Person Learning:

- Upon arrival at school, students who would like a morning snack, will go directly to the café and pick up a “to go” morning snack and consume it in a designated area determined by the building administration.
- During 1st period, teachers will ask students if they will be taking home lunch and breakfast for the following day and notify Food Service.
- Prior to dismissal, students will pick up (from a designated area) their lunch and breakfast for the following day, including milk and juice. The lunch will be frozen and come with heating instructions. *There will be no sale of additional snacks in order to ensure a quick delivery of the meals*

For Students Learning Virtually:

- For students learning from home, meals will be available for pick up at the following 10 schools from **1:00 - 3:00 p.m.:**
 - Carrington Elementary School: 24 Kenmore Avenue
 - Chase Elementary School: 40 Woodtick Road
 - Crosby High School: 300 Pierpont Road
 - Driggs Elementary School: 77 Woodlawn Terrace
 - Gilmartin Elementary School: 94 Spring Lake Road
 - Kennedy High School: 422 Highland Avenue
 - Reed Elementary School: 33 Griggs Street
 - Waterbury Arts Magnet School: 16 South Elm Street
 - Waterbury Career Academy: 175 Birch Street
 - Wilby High School: 568 Bucks Hill Road

- Parents will go to a designated area at the school, provide the student' name and pick up a lunch and breakfast for the following day, including milk and juice. The lunch will be frozen and come with heating instructions.
- Any students participating in an after school program will also be supplied a meal.
