Student Success Plan (SSP)

The Student Success Plan is an individualized student – centered plan that engages every student based on their unique interests and strengths, helping them to understand the relevancy of education to achieve post-secondary educational and/or career goals. Students in grades 6-12 will participate in bi-monthly advisory sessions that will cover lessons that encompass the academic, career and social, emotional and physical development. The SSP will begin in Grade 6 and continue through High School. It will provide students with support and assistance in setting goals for the key components that meet rigorous High School and Post-Secondary expectations. The SSP and supporting activities, such as student portfolios and student records will be electronic and portable.

Core Components

Academic Development:

Students interest and aspiration are the basis for the development of the student’s academic program. A planned program will lead to the acquisition of skills, knowledge and attitudes needed to be an effective learner in school and across their life span.

Career Development:

The student will investigate their own interests and abilities as they relate to the world of work in the dynamic global economy. The customized plan will include varied and flexible educational opportunities, personal connections, and elective coursework, and targeted supports tied to each student’s education and/or career goals.

Social, Emotional, and Physical Development:

The Student Success Plan supports positive social, emotional and physical development, allowing students to more fully engage in the school environment and take the risks necessary for optimal academic performance.
