

Non-resident Enrollment Policy

The Board of Education will permit students from other school districts to attend local schools when they can be accommodated in existing classes. Such requests will be entertained when space is available, having first addressed the needs of the children residing in the City of Waterbury. That such outside enrollment will be contingent on meeting the following criteria:

1. Enrollment in the Waterbury School District will be based on space availability.
2. Student must meet the entrance criteria for the specific program.
3. Student or their sending district shall pay an annual tuition cost which is the cost of tuition for educating a child in the City of Waterbury. This figure is adjusted on an annual basis (see Appendix 11).
4. Parents who are given permission to enroll their children in Waterbury must provide their own transportation to and from the Waterbury Schools.
5. A student who enrolls in the Waterbury School District must follow all guidelines established in the district.
6. There must be a sign-off from the Superintendent of the sending district.
