

Video Studio Facility and Broadcast Policy

The purpose of the Waterbury Schools Video Facility, including its Educational Cable Access Channel, is to engage students in aspects of video editing and video broadcast production, as well as to promote the positive image of Waterbury Schools and the greater community. Its mission is to highlight educational opportunities afforded to public school students via the cable access channel and to broaden the educational base of students in the Waterbury schools. The goals are to provide equal access for all the schools, to provide career training for students in the state-defined school-to-career cluster of arts and media, and to inform the general public of what is happening in the Waterbury Public Schools and the surrounding community.

It is the policy of the Board of Education to retain a log recording the title, time, and date of each program tape aired on Channel 16 and to maintain a library of said program tapes for a period of three years from the last date of broadcast.
