Maloney Magnet School Teachers and Staff will:

- Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that prepares children to succeed and meet the State's student academic achievement standards. The school will provide high-quality curriculum and instruction that meets the needs of all learners.

Parent Responsibilities

- I will listen to my child practice reading for fluency each night through Guided Reading/Squirt assignments.
- Attend Parent Workshops provided by the school and participate in events such as Multicultural events, Math Night, Book Bingo, PTO events, and volunteer when able.
- Establish and follow a daily routine that fosters success at school.
- Provide a space with materials for homework and make education a priority in our home.
- Communicate with my child's teacher and school staff if questions or concerns should arise.
- Reinforce the "Leader in Me" principles your child learns at school and lives at home, becoming a leader of his or her own life.

Students will share the responsibility to improve their academic achievement while showing Paw Pride.

- I will read at least 20 minutes every day outside of school time.
