- E) Student Programs and Projects
- F) Family Night events / Field Trips

Families will be notified about their child's progress, receive explanations of student assessment results and be provided the response in the following ways:

- A) Progress Reports/Report Cards
- B) Conferencing – school, home, phone, letter
- C) mCLASS and i-Ready Results

- A) Families' responsibility for supporting student learning
- B) On-going communication between family and teacher
- C) Student's responsibility for learning
- D) School's responsibility for providing a high quality multicultural curriculum
